Our work this term will be based on the theme of A Frozen Kingdom



Topic Overview:

During this term, we will be learning about the geography of the polar regions. Children will be using atlases and maps to identify a range of physical features and research some of the similarities and difference between the Arctic and the Antarctic.

The children will be learning about some famous explorers and the Race to the North Pole. They will be using these ideas to inspire some story writing using the polar regions as a setting.

In science, children will be researching the different adaptations of animals that live in the extreme polar climates; they will be investigating which type of clothing will be the best for explorers to wear and presenting their results to the design company.
