There are hundreds of thousands of people living in cramped and dirty condition. Imagine living in those conditions and having to try to stop coronavirus!

DSAT work with a charity called Asha who work tirelessly to support the people who live in the slums. During this incredibly difficult time they are going into the slums to help people who are suffering from COVID-19. In Delhi at the moment there are no hospital beds, no COVID tests and there is no oxygen available.
