## COVID Updates

Dear Parents/Carers,

Due to COVID numbers increasing, both across the country and within Parkland school, I am writing to ask you to be extra vigilant in the coming weeks to ensure we do everything we can to stop the spread of COVID. As part of our risk assessment, we ask all children to wash their hands regularly and sanitise throughout the day. We will be ventilating classrooms to ensure there is clean air flow – please ensure your child has **warm clothes**. We also ask that you:

- Wear a **face mask** again when dropping off or collecting your child
- Ensure only **one adult** brings children onto the school premises
- Keep at least a **2m distance** from others

The new guidance is that children under 18 years old do not need to self-isolate, unless they have tested positive, but as I am sure you understand, we want to do everything we can to keep the whole community safe and well.

I would also like to communicate that if we have large numbers of staff away we may not be able to operate fully as a school. If we all work together, I hope we can have a 'normal' half term as possible.
