Year 4 Trip
Bosworth Battlefield, Roman Day – Monday 10th March 2025

It is wonderful to be able to inform you that we have arranged a trip to Bosworth Battlefield to enhance your child's learning about Roman Britain. The date of the trip is **Monday 10th March 2025**.

Bosworth Battlefield Heritage Centre offers a high standard learning experience where the children will be exposed to Roman history, Roman artefacts and facts about the Roman Empire. We hope the Roman themed day will expose and deepen the children's understanding of life during the Roman times across Britain and particularly Leicestershire.

The activities during the day include:

- Explore life in early Roman Britain as Boudica rebels against the might of Rome!
- Meet the rebellious British noblewoman and a Roman soldier
- Discover the secrets of the Bosworth Roman Temple in our Archaeology Detectives session

On the day of the trip, we will leave immediately after the register in the morning and will arrive back at the end of the normal school day for the children to be collected. Children will be expected to wear school uniform and sensible shoes. In case the weather is wet or cold, please also ensure your child comes with a coat. They will also need to bring a packed lunch and drink for the day. *If your child is entitled to a free school meal, a packed lunch can be ordered from the school kitchen in advance.*

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £16.25 per child. *If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the reduced cost will be £8.00.*

We hope you agree that this is an exciting opportunity for the children to experience and immerse themselves into life during the Roman times. To confirm you would like your child to go on the trip and to make a payment please visit our online payment and booking platform – ParentPay.

We will require consent/ payment by Monday 10th February 2025. Please note if insufficient contributions are received, the trip may have to be cancelled.
