Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our PSHE and online safety curriculum, we are planning a school visit to Warning Zone in Leicester on Tuesday 14th January 2025.

Warning Zone is a Leicester based charity dedicated to teaching life-saving skills and safeguarding children through stimulations and memorable experiences. Their mission is to deliver life-saving messages to children aged 10-11 as they venture into secondary school and are introduced to new experiences. Warning Zone aims to educate young people on understanding risks, peer pressure, anti-social behaviour and consequences. We will leave immediately after the register in the morning and will arrive back at school by 3pm. Children will be expected to wear normal school uniform. Your child will also need to bring a packed lunch and drink bottle for the day. *If your child is entitled to a free school meal, a packed lunch can be ordered from the school kitchen in advance, please contact the school office to request one.*

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £19.50 per child. *If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium/Free School Meals, the reduced cost will be £9.75.*

To confirm you would like your child to go on the trip and to make a payment please visit our online payment and booking platform – ParentPay. For those parents who have NOT activated their ParentPay account, an activation letter will be sent home with your child's log in details.

We will require consent/ payment by Friday 13th December 2024. Please note if insufficient contributions are received, the trip may have to be cancelled.
