Dear Parents/ Carers,

Further information about arrangements for reopening

We continue to be busy with our organisation and planning for our possible reopening for Pre-school, EYFS and Year 1 and Year 6. Although we are still not in a position to confirm anything, our planned arrangements are still in line with the previous dates and timings we have given you as below:

- A phased return for these year groups with thorough ongoing risk assessments to ensure it as safe as possible to do so and based on the numbers of those who have said they would like to send their child back to school.
- Pre-school and EYFS to return on Thursday 4th June
- Year 1 to return on Wednesday 10th June (dependent on numbers already attending and staff)
- Then further risk assessments, evaluation of numbers attending, space and staff available to see if we are able to accommodate Year 6 pupils. **Based on our current number predictions, this is highly unlikely.**

In preparation for our possible reopening, and to ensure you have the information you need, I am sending our **Back To School Plan** alongside this letter. This document sets out our current arrangements for how the school will be organised when the children return. It includes information about groups, drop off and collection points, what your child will need to bring etc as well as expectations of your child and you. **It is important that you read this information in preparation for your child returning to school.** Please also discuss it with your child so they have an idea of what to expect if they return. The booklet will also be available on our school website along with other documents such as our updated behaviour policy.

Once we are in a position to confirm a return date for those children whose parents have said they will be returning, we will be in touch. We will be phoning you to inform you of which group your child will be in and where you should bring them in the morning.

Our risk assessment will also be shared with you on our school website in due course and no later than Wednesday once our documentation has been signed off by the Trust.

We hope by sharing the information as it stands will help you to plan and understand some of the key information and we will be in touch as soon as we are able to confirm a return date for your child. Thank you for your ongoing support and understanding with this and we will hopefully see you again very soon!
