



Dear Parents/Carers,

Spring Term Homework

We hope you had a good Christmas and wish you a Happy New Year.

This term, as we start to approach the Year 6 SATs, in May, we would like to trial a new online reading programme for Year 6 Homework. Each week we expect Year 6 pupils to complete at **least two quizzes** on **Read Theory** an online reading practise site. We hope that this will provide the children with additional support and practise at applying their comprehension skills which will help them in their reading SATs paper. They will all be shown how to log in during the first week back, and given log ins. To complete the tasks online they simply need to search *Read Theory log in* or go to <https://readtheory.org/reading/welcomeReader>. They then enter their password, which will be stuck into their homework book.

In addition to this, we would like the children to:

- Complete **30 minutes of Mathletics** choosing from the set tasks each week.
- **Practise the spellings** given to them for a Spelling Test on **Friday each week**.
- Read their AR book for **at least 20 minutes three times a week** (or equivalent e.g. ten minutes a day).

We would like to ask for your support in ensuring your child has completed their homework each week; please sign off the work completed each week in the grid in the pupil's homework book. This will provide us with evidence that this has been completed.

Please note, homework is **due in on a Wednesday** and books will be **handed out again on a Friday**.

Homework Club:

We are aware that not all pupils may have access to the internet or may prefer to complete this in an environment supported by Year 6 staff. Therefore, we would like to offer the children the opportunity to stay after school and complete their homework at a **Year 6 Homework Club on Thursdays** in the Computing Suite. Children will be given a drink and a biscuit after school, and then the club will run **until 4pm**. If you would like your child to attend the club, please complete the form below and inform us if your child can walk home alone or is to be collected. Children can be collected from the back door to Sixacres, just after 4pm.
