## Changes to dinner menu during Shanghai Exchange

We are very excited to be welcoming the teachers from Shanghai next week as we begin the National Shanghai exchange, which we are hosting for the Department for Education. As you are aware, they will be teaching 2DH and 4HW between Monday 14<sup>th</sup> and Friday 25<sup>th</sup> January. During this time, we have teachers coming from across Leicestershire and the East Midlands to observe them teaching Maths lessons. In order to accommodate the numbers of teachers attending, some of these lessons will take place in our school hall.

As a large school, our lunchtimes begin at 11.30am, to ensure that all pupils are able to eat their dinner in a timely manner and give them time to play and spend time outside. With this in mind, we are organising an alternative to school dinners in the hall, whilst we are using this space for the Shanghai Showcase lessons.

We have worked with our kitchen staff to ensure that hot dinner options are still available. The hot meals will be given in a bag. The children will be able to eat these in their classrooms so there will be as little disruption as possible to their lunchtimes.
