YR 6 - Mobile Phones

We are exceptionally proud of the children in year 6 and encourage them to develop their confidence and independence in readiness for their transition to the high school. As part of this we understand that mobile phones are a convenient way for parents and children to communicate with one another in emergencies to and from the school.

There have been incidents of children using their mobile phones in the school day and taking photographs of one another during lessons. All of the children have been spoken to today to remind them of the school's expectations in keeping children and staff at the school safe from unwarranted online images. Please can I ask parents to remind children about the expectations of the school and to support these messages – that children who choose to bring their phones to school must store them in the school office for the duration of the school day (they each have named envelopes in this area).

If children are found to be using their phones in the school day their phones will be removed and parents called to discuss this.
