EYFS Term: Autumn 1

Maths

This term in mathematics we will:

- Count objects carefully
- Recognise numbers to 5
- Explore different representations of numbers to 5
- Using the language of 'more' and 'fewer' to compare two sets of objects
- Exploring Numicon and matching quantity to numerals

English

In English we will:

- Learn about ourselves, our family, our school and where we live
- Learn to listen to and talk about stories
- Sequence stories using picture clues
- Begin to recognise and write sounds/letters
- Begin to hear the first sound in words
- Use role-play to extend language

Our Topic

During this theme we will develop the children's curiosity, understanding and knowledge about themselves and the people and community around them. Children will develop an awareness of what makes them similar and different to others and how to build relationships with others. The children will learn about where they come from and local life.

Autumn 1 Topic: All about me



Understanding the world

In 'Understanding the World' we will:

- Use our senses to explore the world around us
- Talk about things we have observed in the world around us such as plants and animals
- Talk about what makes us special and how we are similar and different to others
- Learn about growing up

Learning outside school

Places you could visit:

- Visit a park or woods (such as Bradgate Park or Brocks Hill Country park) and explore in the woodland area - collect things to talk about and label back at home
- Go to the library and borrow some books about growing up, starting school or families

For mathematics you could:

- Support your child with recognising numbers
- Counting objects carefully
- Talk about and compare everyday objects who has more or fewer?

For English you could:

- Share stories with your child
- Ask questions about your child's school day and encourage them to talk about their likes and dislikes
