Year 4 Term: Autumn 1



This half term, our focus in Maths is <u>place value</u>. Children will revise their understanding of 3-digit numbers before moving on to create, partition and compare 4-digit numbers.

We will also learn how to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 using the rule; 5 or more, let is soar! 5 or less, let it rest!

At the end of Year 4, children will complete the Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). It is therefore vital we continue to practice all of the times tables. This half term we are revising x2, x5 and x10 to build our fluency.

Wider Curriculum Learning Journeys

In Science this half term we will explore the names and functions of human teeth before learning what happens to the food we eat as it travels along our digestive system! Children will use all of the knowledge they gain to present their findings to the rest of the class.

Reading

This half term in Reading, we will focus on the skills of retrieval, inference and understanding of vocabulary. Our texts each week also link to the knowledge we are building in our wider curriculum. Our class text is Demon Dentist by David Walliams.

English

- expanded noun phrases
- fronted adverbials
- direct speech
- conjunctions
- contractions
