EYFS

Term: Autumn 2

Maths

This term in mathematics we will:

- Explore numbers to 5
- Find one more and one less
- Partitioning numbers to 5 e.g. finding different ways of making 5
- Comparing shapes
- Solving addition and subtraction problems with numbers up to 5.

English

In English we will:

- Learn some stories
- Sequence stories using picture clues
- Begin to write simple words
- Begin to write simple captions
- Write sentences about the stories we learn as a class
- Use role-play to extend language - castle, beanstalk, cottage etc.

Our Topic

During this theme we will develop the children's understanding and knowledge of fairy tales and religious and world festivals. Children will learn about different religious and cultural celebrations around the world. Children will develop their vocabulary and an understanding of fairytales and how they are structured.

Understanding the World

In 'Understanding the World' we will:

- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.
- Recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries

Learning Outside School

Places you could visit:

- Go to the library and borrow some fairytale or non-fiction books
- A castle (Warwick castle, Rockingham Castle, Ashby de le Zouch Castle)

For mathematics you could:

- Find one more or one less using objects
- Addition and subtraction in an everyday context e.g. There are 3 apples and 2 bananas in the bowl. How *many pieces are there altogether?*

For English you could:

- Share stories with your child
- Encourage your child to recognise and read sounds and words in books
- Encourage your child to write
- Ask questions about your child's school day
