This term, we will be continuing to learn about:

• Addition and subtraction of upto 3-digit numbers with and without renaming.

 Multiplication and division using a range of strategies supported by our times tables knowledge.

Wider Curriculum Learning Journeys

In History, we are learning about Prehistoric Britain, the different periods and how life was similar and different across these periods. In Science, we are learning about plants (how they grow, the parts of a flower and how water moves in a plant light) and rocks and soils (the different types and how they are formed). In DT, we will be designing and making a Beaker Bell pot.



Reading

This term in reading, we are learning to use inference skills whilst continuing to retrieve and develop our understanding of vocabulary from a range of texts (narrative, poetry and explanation texts).
