EYFS Term: Spring 1



This term in gymnastics we will:

- Revise and refine the fundamental movement skills we have already acquired: rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, running, hopping, skipping and climbing.
- Show good control and co-ordination in large and small movements. Move confidently in a range of ways, safely negotiating space.

English

In English we will:

- Attempt to write sentences in meaningful contexts.
- Continue to practise writing our names.
- Write labels and captions
- Use vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by books we have read.
- Engage in extended conversations about stories related to pets.
- Blend to read simple captions.

Our Topic

During this theme we will develop the children's understanding and knowledge of animals. Children will learn to show care and concern for living animals and the environment. They will also learn to make observations of animals.

To develop communication and language we will:

- Listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding.
- Connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives.

In maths we will be:

- Comparing numbers up to 5.
- Exploring the composition of numbers 6, 7
 and 8.
- Making pairs
- Combining 2 groups (addition)
- Comparing mass & capacity
- Learning about length & height
- Finding 1 more and 1 less
