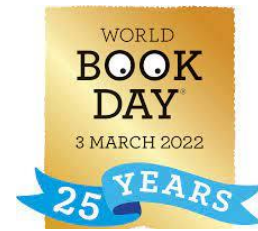

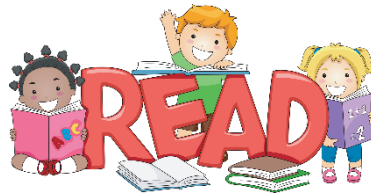


## World Book Day – Thursday 3<sup>th</sup> March 2022
