EYFS Term: Spring 2



This term in mathematics we will be:

- Exploring the composition of numbers 9 and 10
- Finding one more and one less
- Learning number bonds to 10
- Comparing length and height
- Combining two groups
- Learning about 3D shapes

English

In English we will:

- Learn how to read and write phase 3 tricky words
- Apply phase 2 and 3 sounds to help read and write words and captions e.g. ship, thing, chat, rain, see, goat.
- Read fiction and non-fiction texts related to farming
- Continue to learn new graphemes in phonics
- Begin to read simple sentences
- Continue to write simple words and captions <u>independently</u>

Our Topic

During this half-term our learning will be based around the topic of farming. We will be reading lots of stories with a farming theme such as, *The Little Red Hen* and *Jack and The Enormous Turnip*. We will also be reading some non-fiction texts about farms.

Understanding the World

In 'Understanding the World' we will:

- Learn about similarities and differences in relation to living things
- Make observations of animals and plants and explain why some things occur, and talk about changes

Learning Outside School

Places you could visit:

• A local farm to see animals being born/hatching including chicks.

For mathematics you could:

- Find one more or one less using objects (up to 10)
- Help your child spot and recognise different 2D and 3D shapes in the environment
- Use fingers to help you remember the number bonds to 10

- Encourage your child to write
