Year 1

Term: Summer 1

Maths

In maths this term Year 1 will be introduced to multiplication and division with the use of arrays and grouping.

Children will also begin to recognise o'clock and half past the hour times on an analogue clock. We will continue to develop our place value knowledge of numbers to 100.

Wider Curriculum Learning Journeys

In Science we will be learning about the parts of the body and some of the names of the bones in the skeleton. We will also learn about our senses.

In History we will be learning about significant individuals from the past who have contributed to national and international achievements for example Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.

Reading

This term children will be preparing for the Phonics Screening Check by reading real and nonsense words with a range of digraphs and trigraphs. We will be sharing guided reading texts and discussing what we know about what we have read. We will also continue to use Sammy SMILES to help us discuss and make predictions about stories.

Summer 1 Topic: Bones and Bodies



Computing

This term in computing Year 1 will be learning to type using a keyboard on a laptop. Children will create a word document using what they have learnt in our topic lessons.

English

In English this term we will read stories linked to our topic and re-write our own narratives with alternative endings. We will learn the rules to apply different suffixes such as -ing, -ed, -er and -est. We will be learning to write non-fiction reports about the body and our senses. We will also be composing our own poems and reciting them too.
