EYFS

Term: Summer 2

## Maths

This term in mathematics we will learn about:

- Odd and even numbers
- Doubling and halving
- Problem solving
- Sharing

## English

In English/Phonics we will:

- Learn how to read and write phase 3 and 4 tricky words
- Apply phase 3 sounds to help read and write words e.g. nurse, brown, better, fair, pure
- Read fiction and non-fiction texts about sports
- Continue to learn new graphemes in phonics and consolidate our Phase 3 sounds
- Read sentences
- Write words and sentences **independently** remembering to use capital letters, finger

## Our Topic

During this term we will develop the children's engagement in learning through our topic on sport & exercise. The topic will include non-fiction texts on different sports as well stories with a sport theme such as 'The Hare and The Tortoise' and 'Mr Men Sports'. The children will continue to develop their understanding of why it's important to keep active.

## Understanding the world

In 'Understanding the World' we will:

- *Recognise some environments that are different from the one in which we live.*
- *Explore the natural world around us.*
- Learn to show care and concern for living things and the environment

## Learning outside school

Places you could visit:

- A local park with a race track
- A swimming pool
- The ground of a local sports team

For mathematics you could:

- *Support your child in recognising and ordering numbers to 20*
- *Practise doubling numbers up to 5.*
- *Talk about odd and even numbers*
- *Watch 'Numberblocks' on Cbeebies to improve your child's understanding of number composition*

For English you could:

- Listen to your child read daily - even if it's just a page or two!
- Practise reading and spelling phase 3 and 4 tricky words
- Encourage your child to write at home e.g. writing facts about different sports
